

# Out of Order

---

**A motion is “out of order”** when it is moved while a motion of higher precedence is pending.

**A person is “out of order”** when speaking without recognition of the chairperson  
or  
when a person who is not a member in good standing of the organization speaks.

Note: some organizations allow input from everyone in attendance; only those with voting power are able to vote.

**A remark is “out of order”** when it violates a ruling of the organization.
