RE: NEW AEFI REPORT FORM AND USER GUIDE

Dear Health Care Provider:

Manitoba Health, Seniors and Active Living (MHSAL) has revised the Adverse Events Following Immunization (AEFI) report form. Henceforth, please use this new, revised form when reporting AEFIs.

The form and user guide can be downloaded from http://www.gov.mb.ca/health/publichealth/cdc/div/aefi.html (look under Manitoba Health Resources).

As with the old report form, the new form is a fillable pdf and may be saved along with information typed in. *Rather than printing a blank form then completing by hand, it is recommended that the form be completed electronically.*

The format of the report form is drastically different from that of the old form in order to conform to the lay-out of the new provincial immunization registry, where AEFI reports will be recorded in association with immunization records. Thus, it is imperative that this new form be used instead of the old one going forward.
