The Clerk formally advised the Assembly that Mr. Speaker was unavoidably absent and called upon the Deputy Speaker to take the Chair pursuant to the Statutes. The Deputy Speaker took the Chair at 1:30 p.m.

Immediately following the Prayer, Mrs. STEFANSON rose on a Matter of Privilege regarding the First Minister's comments on Bill (No. 5) and moved:

THAT this matter be referred to the Committee on Legislative Affairs.

And Hon. Mr. BLAIKIE and Mr. LAMOUREUX having spoken.

WHEREUPON Madam Deputy Speaker ruled there was no Matter of Privilege.

From her decision, Mr. HAWRANIK appealed to the House,

And the Question being put, "Shall the ruling of the Chair be sustained?" It was agreed to, on division.

The following petitions were presented and read:

Mr. BRIESE – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to request the appropriate ministers of the Provincial Government to consider outlining to Parks Canada the importance that a viable recreational facility in the Mount Agassiz area would play in the local and provincial economies and to consider working with all stakeholders, including Parks Canada, to help develop a plan for a viable, multi-season recreation facility in the Mount Agassiz area. Mrs. DRIEDGER – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to request that the Provincial Government consider immediately providing Revlimid as a choice to patients with Multiple Myeloma and their health care providers in Manitoba through public funding. (D. Holdsworth, M. Harapiak, E. Huska and others)
