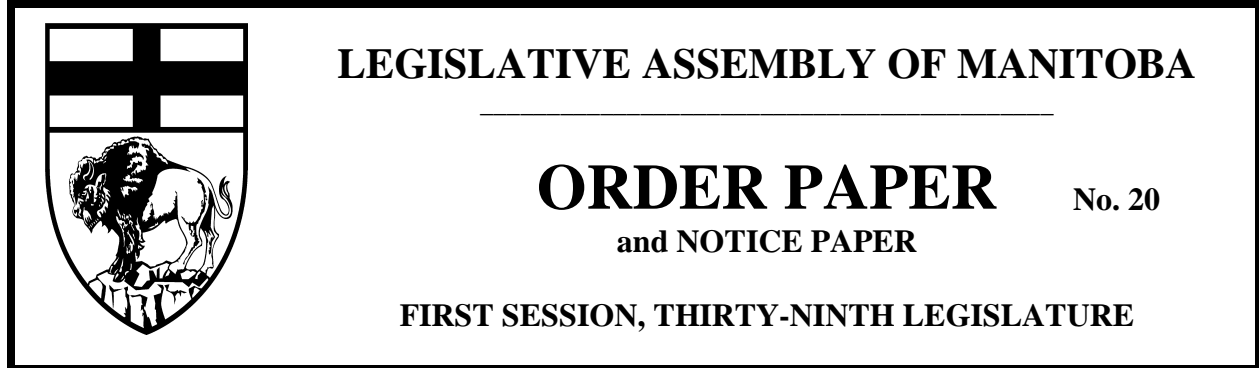

RESOLUTION:

Mr. FAURSCHOU – Beverage Container Deposit System

6. WHEREAS Manitoba is the only province besides Ontario that does not have a comprehensive deposit-return system for beverage containers other than beer cans and bottles; and

WHEREAS the government of Manitoba has failed to take advantage of reusable electronic components, preferring to contribute to greenhouse gas emissions by incinerating them; and

WHEREAS the government of Manitoba has mismanaged the tire stewardship program, resulting in the accumulation of used tires while businesses cannot afford to continue the program; and

WHEREAS the government of Manitoba should not repeat these failures by allowing the province's recovery rate for beverage containers – other than beer cans and bottles – to remain consistently lower than other provinces that offer deposit-return systems; and

WHEREAS in Manitoba the industry-managed system for beer can and bottle recovery has proven that a deposit-return system can be successful; and

WHEREAS a beverage container deposit-return system would reduce litter and increase recycling of beverage containers currently sent to landfills; and

WHEREAS a beverage container deposit-return system could provide an important means of fundraising for charitable and not-for-profit- community groups; and

WHEREAS a beverage container deposit-return system is a cost-effective means of protecting the environment to the benefit of all Manitobans.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Assembly of Manitoba urge the Provincial Government to consider implementing a comprehensive beverage container deposit-return system in Manitoba.
