**AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION  
UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT**

**RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and PARKLAND FEEDS LTD., Applicant,**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Parkland Feeds Ltd. filed a proposal with the department in connection with the operation of a feed mill located in the NE1/4 of Section 2, Township 25, Range 19 WPM on Provincial Trunk Highway No. 20 East in the Town of Dauphin, Manitoba;

**AND WHEREAS** in the absence of limits, terms and conditions prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the proposal was referred to The Clean Environment Commission to prescribe limits, terms and conditions;

**AND WHEREAS** after giving notice of the proposal, the Commission did not receive notice of representation from any person who was likely to be affected by the issuance a Commission order concerning the said operation;

**AND WHEREAS** the Commission considered the proposal on the 23rd day of October, 1984;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT**

1. The Applicant shall limit the emission of particulate matter from the said operation to such an extent that particulate emissions do not exceed a concentration of 0.57 grams per standard cubic metre at the point of emission calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimetres of mercury.
2. The Applicant shall limit the emission of particulate matter from the said operation to such an extent that airborne particulate matter from any part or process of the said operation does not at any time remain visible beyond the property line of the said operation.

3. The Applicant shall at all times maintain a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping consistent with meeting the requirements of Clause 1 and 2 of this order.
