In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: The "Licencee"

for the construction of the Development being the upgrading of a section of Provincial Road #373 beginning at the Jenpeg Generating Station and extending along the roadway 3.5 km east subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:

SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the *Manitoba Department of Highways and Transportation Location Plan of P.R. #373 (south east of Jenpeg)*, filed as part of the Environment Act Proposal, dated November 4, 1992.
2. The Licencee shall, during construction, comply with all requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products*.
- 3) The Licencee shall, upon completion of construction, cleanup and remove all debris from the construction site and dispose of the debris at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to MR 150/91 respecting Waste Disposal Grounds.

REVOCATION

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not or is not complying with the specifications, terms or conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
