In accordance with the Manitoba Environment Act (C.C.S.M. c. E125)

THIS LICENCE IS ISSUED TO:

**THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF  
HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION: The "Licencee"**

for the construction and operation of the Development being the upgrading of Provincial Road #355 located in the Rural Municipality of Blanshard beginning at Cardale and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 6.5 km. to the west junction with Provincial Road #250 subject to the following specifications, limits, terms and conditions:


**SPECIFICATIONS, LIMITS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1) The Licencee shall construct the Development in accordance with the Department of Highways & Transportation Environment Act Proposal, *Proposed Upgrading of Provincial Road #355 (from Cardale to the west junction with PR #250)*, filed with the Department on January 28, 1993.
- 2) The Licencee shall, prior to construction of the wetland replacement area for the Development, submit a Wetland Replacement Mitigation & Management Plan for the Development to the Director for approval. The Plan shall be prepared in consultation with representatives from the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources and the North American Waterfowl Management Plan. The Wetland Replacement Mitigation & Management Plan shall:
  - a) identify the source of water for the wetland replacement area related to the Development;
  - b) describe measures to maintain drainage patterns and prevent sedimentation in wetlands from disturbed areas related to the Development;
  - c) identify the native plant species to be seeded and the schedule for seeding in the wetland replacement area related to the Development; and
  - d) provide an estimate of the amount of land surrounding the wetland replacement area to be converted to dense nesting cover.
- 3) The Licencee shall, prior to construction of the Development, reach an agreement with the Department of Natural Resources Water Resources Branch in Neepawa regarding culvert design and placement for the Development.

- 4) The Licencee shall, prior to construction, consult and reach an agreement with the Manitoba Department of Natural Resources and Manitoba Hydro regarding the method of placement of all hydro poles to be relocated into wetland areas.
- 5) The Licencee shall, prior to construction, reach an agreement with the Department of Environment, Park-West Region on the location of the asphalt batching plant associated with the Development.
- 6) The Licencee shall ensure that all fuel storage areas associated with the Development comply with the requirements of *Manitoba Regulation 97/88R* respecting *Storage and Handling of Gasoline and Associated Products Regulation*.
- 7) The Licencee shall, during construction, dispose of all sewage and sullage from sanitary facilities associated with the Development in accordance with *Manitoba Regulation 95/88R* respecting *Private Sewage Disposal System and Privies*.
- 8) The Licencee shall, during the full term of the construction of the Development, cleanup and deposit all debris from the construction site at a Waste Disposal Ground operating under the authority of a permit issued pursuant to *Manitoba Regulation 150/91R* respecting *Waste Disposal Grounds*.
- 9) The Licencee shall ensure that any construction camps associated with the Development comply with all requirements *Manitoba Regulation 35/88R* respecting *Industrial and Construction Camp Regulation*.

#### **REVOCATION**

If in the opinion of the Director the Licencee has exceeded or is exceeding the limits, or has not complied or is not complying with the specifications, terms and conditions set out herein, the Director may revoke, temporarily or permanently, this Licence.
