

AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION

UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and CORDITE CONCRETE LTD., Applicant,

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Cordite Concrete Ltd., filed a proposal with the Department of Mines, Resources and Environmental Management for the operation of a concrete batching plant located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16-11-4 EPM on the land described in Appendix "A" attached to this order, in the Rural Municipality of Springfield, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation under the said Act, the proposal was referred to the said Commission to prescribe limits;

AND WHEREAS no representation was made to the said Commission by any person who is, or is likely to be, affected by an Order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS the said Commission considered the application on the 24th day of March, 1975;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT


1. The Applicant shall ensure that solid particulate emissions from any process in the said operation do not exceed 0.57 grams per standard cubic meter calculated at 20 degrees Celsius and 760 millimetres of mercury (0.25 grains per standard cubic foot calculated at 68 degrees Fahrenheit and 30 inches of mercury), at the point of emission.
2. The Applicant shall ensure that a high standard of housekeeping and maintenance are carried out at all times in a manner consistent with meeting the limits prescribed in Clause 1.

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

All that portion of the most Northerly One Hundred and Sixty-five (165) feet of the South Half of the North East Quarter of Section Sixteen (16) in the Eleventh (11) Township and Fourth (4) Range, East of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, which lies to the East of a line drawn East of, paralld with and perpendicularly distant One Hundred (100) feet from the Eastern limit of the land taken for the right-of-way of the Canadian National Railway as same is shown on a plan registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 7416.
