Bloom Distribution Terminal Bulk Anhydrous Ammonia Storage and Bulk Granular Fertilizer Storage Facility

I am submitting for your information, details on a planned expansion of the dry fertilizer storage warehouse for the Bloom Distribution Terminal Bulk Anhydrous Ammonia Storage and Bulk Granular Fertilizer Storage Facility. The terminal currently operates under Environment Act License No. 1331 RRR. The purpose of this project is to increase the dry fertilizer storage capacity by 18,000 metric tons. The dry fertilizer products stored will not change (monoammonium phosphate, urea and ammonium sulphate). There will be no change to the fundamentals and principles of the process streams already in operation today. In addition, there will be no changes to existing emissions.

The details of the project are as described in the attached reference drawings.


The planned alterations will adhere to Section 4 of License 1331 RRR in that Agrium Inc. will obtain all necessary permits prior to commencement of construction.

It is our opinion that the application fee would not apply as the alterations will be to equipment and works that do not change the environmental effects, and therefore does not require any amendments to existing Environment Act License 1331 RRR.

Preliminary schedule for this project is for construction to start in Q3, 2020 with a completion date before end of the year.
