RE: Request to Suspend Clause 1 e) of Environment Act Licence No. 1399

This letter acknowledges the request submitted by Parks and Regional Services on June 10, 2016 to commence the discharge of effluent from the Brereton Lake wastewater treatment lagoon after the allowable discharge period that is specified in Environment Act Licence 1399.

The discharge was delayed to allow for additional treatment of the effluent to reduce the total phosphorus concentration to 1.0 mg/L or lower. Laboratory analysis reports provided by Parks and Regional Services confirm that all effluent quality parameters comply with Environment Act Licence No. 1399. Discharge of treated effluent into a wetland that drains into the Rennie River.

Pursuant to Section 18(1) of *The Environment Act*, I am granting a suspension of clause 1 e) of Environment Act Licence 1399 to allow commencement of the discharge after May 31, 2016. The suspension is in effect from June 14, 2016 to June 20, 2016 inclusive for this event.

All other clauses of Environment Act Licence No. 1399 remain in effect.
