**Re: Request to extend current terms and conditions of Manitoba
Environment Act Licence 2191E to December 31, 2012**

Thank you for your letter dated October 29, 2010, in which you provided an extension to the terms and conditions identified in the Manitoba Environment Act Licence 2191E through to December 31, 2011.

Manitoba Conservation and LP continue to work on resolving wood supply analysis issues, with stakeholder consultations to be conducted following finalization of the plan. As the remaining work is expected to take at least a number of months to complete, **please accept this letter as LP's formal request to extend the current terms and conditions of Manitoba Environment Act Licence 2191E to December 31, 2012.** In the event that the FMP continues to undergo regulatory review and/or additional time is required for EALB review and approval of the final plan towards the end of 2012, LP may request an additional extension to the Environment Act Licence at that time.
