

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

CARTIER REGIONAL WATER COOPERATIVE INC. - WATER TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION – FILE: 4351.10

A proposal has been filed by the Manitoba Water Services Board on behalf of the Cartier Regional Water Cooperative Inc. for the expansion of the cooperative's water treatment capability. The expansion involves the construction of a new membrane filtration water treatment plant at Headingley, which would obtain its raw water supply from the Assiniboine River. The plant would be capable of treating water at a rate of 120 litres per second, and would supply current and future municipal water needs in Headingley and other areas on the eastern side of the cooperative's service area, including the CentrePort Canada area in the Rural Municipality of Rosser. Approximately 21 km of distribution pipeline would also be constructed as part of the project. Construction is anticipated to begin in the spring of 2014.
