**Re: ErosionControlBlanket Inc – Notice of Alteration**

Thank you for the Notice of Alteration (NoA) dated March 15, 2017 in which you requested an approval, until March 1, 2018, to temporary burn organic waste and short straw from your facility at SW 15-23-4EPM. It is understood that you also proposed to install and commission a baler operation by March 2018 that enables you to sell these wastes. As a long term plan you included a proposal to construct a burn cell at SW 15-23-4 EPM and properly burn excess baled waste that cannot be sold.

Upon review of your alteration request, I have concluded that the environmental effects of the NoA will be insignificant, and therefore in accordance with Section 14(2) of *The Environment Act* you are hereby authorized to carry out the proposed alteration as described in the March 15, 2017 NoA. This approval is conditional on compliance with the burning requirements of the Rural Municipality of Bifrost-Riverton.
