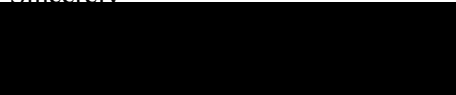
Flying Nickel Mining Corp. is pleased to submit the attached Notice of Alteration to Environment Act Licence No. 2981 for the Minago Nickel Project. This NOA has been developed to address the outstanding information requirements related to the 2014 NOA submission by the previous project owner, Victory Nickel, that remains in process. The NOA also describes any additional project changes proposed by Flying Nickel beyond those considered in the previous NOA and assesses the environmental effects of these additional changes.

Sulphide nickel deposits, like Minago, are a key source of the nickel used in batteries for electric vehicles, and this demand has resulted in a greatly improved nickel price compared to a decade ago. Flying Nickel is working to advance the Minago Project, and we hope take advantage of this strong nickel price environment. We also see it as critical that the Minago Project take a leading role in environmental protection and management so that the nickel produced from this mine for use in electric vehicles to help control climate change leaves as small an environmental footprint as possible.

We also appreciate the timely assistance of your staff on reviews of earlier drafts of this submission, it has improved as a result of their input. Our understanding is that a \$500 fee applies to this NOA submission and, if possible, we would like to expedite payment by credit card.
