Re: Imperial Oil, Environment Act Licence No. 3088

This is to acknowledge the request made by telephone to Environment Officer Julie Froese on May 19, 2022 and the follow up email dated May 20, 2022 requesting an emergency discharge from the temporary storm water containment pond without confirmation of the results of the acute lethality analysis as stipulated in Environment Act Licence No. 3088 to a quantity of approximately 5000 m³.

The request has been reviewed and pursuant to Clause 18(1) of The Environment Act, a suspension to Clause 17 (b) is hereby granted. The suspension of the licence is in effect from May 20, 2022 to May 22, 2022 inclusive, and limited to discharging 5,000 m³ of storm water. All other clauses of the licence shall remain in effect.

Once the acute lethality results are received, the analytical report must be submitted to the Environmental Compliance and Enforcement Branch for confirmation.
