If there is, it should be protected from potential for causing contamination of the public water system by installation of backflow prevention devices in accordance with the provisions of *The Manitoba Plumbing Code*.

Apart from this, Office of Drinking Water has no other concerns with this EAP respecting drinking water safety.

The Groundwater Management Section has reviewed the EAP 5705.00 application and has the following comment.

The collection facility is located in an area where the overburden protection above the carbonate aquifer is thin and therefore may be at a higher risk to contamination. The carbonate aquifer is used as a drinking water source in the immediate area. To protect the underlying groundwater and its users the operator of the facility should ensure that any contaminant release from accidents or malfunctions be immediately cleaned-up.
