RE: RW Packaging Ltd. – Notice of Alteration to Licence 3188

Thank you for the email dated April 21, 2020 and additional information provided on May 4, 2020 in which you requested to reuse poly tanks decommissioned in 2017 in accordance with Clause 28 of Licence 3188. It is indicated that the poly tanks will be reused for the manufacturing of hand sanitizers required to handle the current COVID-19 pandemic. Considering RW Packaging Ltd. as an essential Manitoba industry that continues to provide critical services to communities amidst the prevailing COVID-19 pandemic, your request has been accepted as a Notice of Alteration.

I reviewed your alteration request and concluded that the environmental effects of the proposed temporary alteration will be insignificant, and, therefore, in accordance with Section 14(2) of The Environment Act your alteration is approved as described in the April 21, 2020 Notice of Alteration. This temporary approval will expire July 31, 2020 unless extended by the Director. This approval is conditional on the following requirements:

- Approval of the Winnipeg Fire Paramedic Services (WFPS) before commencing the operation is required.
- Notification of the City of Winnipeg approval must be provided to the Environment Officer prior to start of production.
- Notification of production start and end dates must be provided to the Environment Officer.
- Should you consider a permanent change to the production of hand sanitizer, a submission of a Notice of Alteration with detailed environmental report is required for the Director's review and approval.

Manitoba Conservation and Climate is committed to providing the necessary support during this pandemic so that the industry can provide uninterrupted services.
