

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Conservation and Water Stewardship has received a proposal pursuant to *The Environment Act* regarding the following operation and invites public participation in the review process:

VILLAGE OF DUNNOTTAR WASTEWATER TREATMENT LAGOON – PASSIVE FILTER PROJECT FILE: 914.20

A proposal has been filed on behalf of Village of Dunnottar pursuant to *The Environment Act* for the construction and operation of a full-scale passive filter system in conjunction with existing Village of Dunnottar wastewater treatment lagoon located in the northwest quarter of section 8-17-4 EPM in the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews, to reduce total phosphorus annual loading to Lake Winnipeg. The passive filter will consist of two 25 metre x 50 metre cells, an ultraviolet (UV) disinfection component and influent and effluent manholes and pumps. Treated effluent from the passive filter and UV will be discharged between June 16th and September 15th of any year directly to the existing lagoon drainage channel, which eventually flows to Lake Winnipeg.
