**RE: Environment Act Licence Suspension
Discharge of Effluent from the Miami Wastewater Treatment Lagoon**

This letter acknowledges the emailed request submitted by the Rural Municipality of Thompson on August 5, 2016, to commence discharge of effluent from the secondary cell of the Miami Wastewater Treatment Lagoon without meeting the effluent limit for total coliform specified in Environment Act Licence 2099.

I am granting a suspension of Clause 18(c) (iii) of Environment Act Licence No. 2099 pursuant to Section 18(1) of *The Environment Act* which allows you to proceed with the discharge of the secondary cell of the lagoon. The suspension is in effect from August 8, 2016, to August 22, 2016 inclusive for this event.

Please be advised that if weather conditions become unsuitable, discharge must cease and authorization may be revoked. All other clauses in Environment Act Licence No. 2099 remain in effect.
