

Responsibilities

Hazardous Waste Carriers

Only licensed carriers or transporters may transport hazardous waste in Manitoba. Anyone who transports hazardous waste from one property to another over public roads must possess a valid licence.

Following is a summary of the basic responsibilities of hazardous waste carriers in terms of the hazardous waste tracking system:

- Must possess a hazardous waste transporter licence (with the exception of certain materials that are exempted from the legislation).
- Submit Application for a Licence to Transport Hazardous Waste to Manitoba Environment and Climate Change in order to be assigned Provincial ID No. (Licence No.) as a hazardous waste carrier.
- Compliance with the terms and conditions associated with the licence.
- Prior to picking up hazardous waste, ensure that the waste generator is registered.
- Complete Part B of the manifest and retain the appropriate copy for two years.
