## SEVEN SISTERS GENERATING STATION – SHORT-TERM EXTENSION LICENCE

We request a renewal of the Short-Term Extension Licence (STEL) for the Seven Sisters Generating Station under the provisions of Section 92 of Water Power Regulation 25/88R. We request that the STEL be renewed for a five-year term. The Third STEL was issued for a five-year term on September 8, 2020.
